










What & Why? Theories and Variables

Progress	Need to Consider
Moved from observation to clinical trials	Mechanism(s) of change
Published systematic reviews	Collaborative, large scale clinical trials
Included physiological variables	Theory based research
Introduced some theories	Stronger methodology
Improved funding	Replication and expansion
